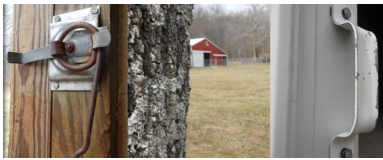


The Benefit of In-Kennel Training

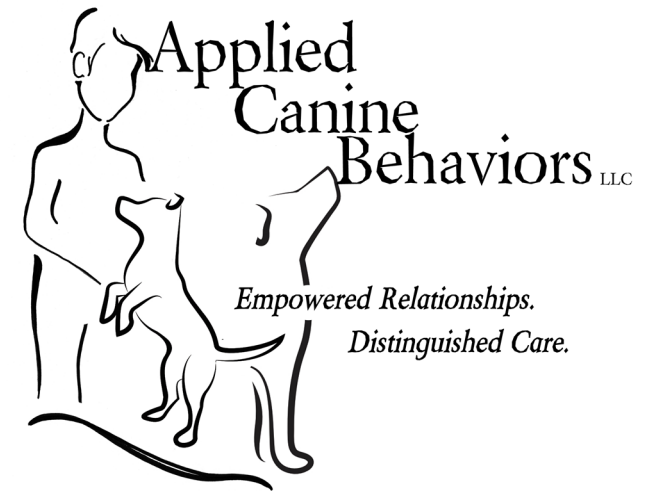

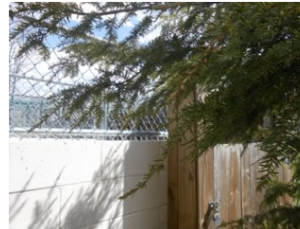
